

Executive Board Officer Nominations – ASEE North Central Section

Deadline for Nominations is 5 PM on Friday, February 17, 2017

The ASEE North Central Section (NCS) Executive Board is seeking nominations for available officer positions. Because this spring's regional conference is a Zone conference being held in Puerto Rico, it has been decided by the NCS Executive Board that the election process for section officers will be done by an e-mail ballot. This potentially allows for greater participation in the voting process than what would be possible if voting was limited to only the section members able to attend the Zone conference in Puerto Rico.

Requirements to be a nominee for an ASEE NCS Executive Board officer position:

- A member in good standing with the ASEE National organization.
- Based on your geographic location, you are a member of the North Central Section.
- For those interested in the Section Chair position, you must have served a term as either a Vice-Chair or a Director of the NCS section.

It is highly recommended that you be able to attend the section's annual regional conference. The Spring 2018 conference will be held in Akron OH, and the Spring 2019 conference is expected to be held in Grand Rapids, MI.

It is highly recommended that you be able to attend the fall Executive Board meeting, at a location to be determined by the Board.

People interested in being nominated for an officer position must provide a biographical sketch (200 words or less) to Andrew Kline, NCS Past Chair, by 5 PM on Friday, February 17. The biographical sketch should include your teaching and research interests, and past involvement with ASEE. A document file in MS Word format sent as an attachment to andrew.kline@wmich.edu is preferred. Include e-mail and phone contact information and the officer position you wish to be nominated for, in addition to the biographical sketch.

Self-nominations are welcome. All nominees will be asked to confirm their interest before being placed on the ballot. Voting for the officer positions will occur using an e-mail ballot that will be distributed to all section members after officer nominations have closed at 5 PM on February 17.
