One of my favorite aspects of the NCS is the collegial nature of the participants and the chance to work with faculty from other campuses who focus on student education.

For years, NCS has identified one nominated faculty member with the Outstanding Teaching Award. We have a number of exceptional early career faculty in the section and want to recognize them. I am pleased to announce the NCS board approved two awards beginning in 2024 and have created an additional award specifically for those in the first five years of teaching in addition to our traditional Outstanding Teaching Award for faculty at any point in their career.

As Vice Chair, one of the duties is to oversee the Outstanding Teaching Award. We ask that you identify the best teaching faculty on your campus and nominate them for this award. The winner of NCS section Outstanding Faculty Award becomes eligible for the national award process. Nominations open in November and close in February each year, so please send them in early. A committee of NCS members will evaluate the nominations and determine the winners. Awards winners are announced at the spring conference, held this year in Kalamazoo, MI on March 22, 23, 2024. The section provides a \$400 honorarium as well as a plaque and certificate from ASEE.
